### AN ACT REQUIRING THE TEACHING OF CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION IN HIGH SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 916 of the acts of 1977, is hereby further  
3 amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following sentence: — The department of education  
5 shall pay for the cost of instruction in cardiopulmonary  
6 resuscitation which shall be mandatory for all high school  
7 students.
