*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting

- 3 Section 24P. The registrar shall immediately suspend, for a
- 4 period of five years, the license or right to operate a motor vehicle
- 5 of any person convicted of the unlawful transportation of a
- 6 controlled substance under the provisions of chapter ninety-
