

to existing school structures, and for originally equipping and furnishing the same, the town of Easton may borrow, from time to time, within a period of five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, three hundred and fifty-five thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the town therefor which shall bear on their face the words, Easton School Building Loan, Act of 1950. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit and shall, except as herein provided, be subject to the provisions of chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE COMMISSION TO APPROVE A GRANT TO THE CITY OF TAUNTON AS PARTIAL REIMBURSEMENT TO SAID CITY FOR THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONS TO THE LEONARD AND VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS IN SAID CITY. Chap.569

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any provision of chapter six hundred and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight to the contrary, the school building assistance commission, established by section one of said chapter, is hereby authorized upon formal application as provided in section seven of said chapter, by the city of Taunton, to approve reimbursement to said city, as provided in section nine of said chapter, for the cost of certain additions to the Leonard school and to the Vocational school in said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO THE CITY OF CHELSEA AS COMPENSATION FOR THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WAYS IN SAID CITY MADE NECESSARY BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MYSTIC RIVER BRIDGE. Chap.570

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. There shall be paid to the city of Chelsea from the Highway Fund the sum of two hundred thousand dollars, after appropriation, as compensation for the cost of construction and reconstruction of public ways in said city made necessary by the construction of the Mystic River bridge.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
