AN ACT PROMOTING CREATIVE RETIREMENT OPTIONS FOR TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 15 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new
3 section: —

4 Section 62. The Board of Education is hereby authorized and
5 directed to develop and maintain guidelines to encourage and
6 promote selected teachers eligible for retirement to continue to
7 engage in teaching on a part-time basis. The Board shall
8 disseminate information to teachers and school committees
9 detailing the benefits to students, schools, teaches and school
10 systems by taking advantage of retiring teachers' skills and
11 experience to train entering teachers, to provide release coverage
12 for teachers engaging in activities outside the classroom, to focus
13 on curriculum development or administrative duties, or to
14 continue teaching in a more limited capacity through arranging
15 for innovative and flexible employment opportunities.
