AN ACT TO PROVIDE PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF THE PROPERTY OF APPLICANTS FOR STATE-SUPPORTED HOUSING UNITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following
- 3 section: —
- 4 Section 60. Public Notices Regarding Eligibility Lists. The
- 5 Department shall promulgate regulations applicable to all
- 6 housing authorities and other agencies within the Commonwealth
- 7 who administer housing subsidy programs in the Commonwealth,
- 8 to assure that said housing authorities and other agencies maintain
- 9 for public inspection at reasonable times a list of all apparently
- 10 qualified applicants for said programs, together with the dates on
- 11 which their applications were made, said lists to be maintained
- 12 in the order of priority of said applicants for said programs.
