By Ms. Buell of Greenfield, petition of Carmen D. Buell relative to authorizing the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to issue handicapped persons license plates to certain state and private agencies. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF HANDICAPPED PLATES TO CERTAIN AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws as amended by
2 section 2 of chapter 221 of the acts of 1988, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the seventh paragraph the following
4 paragraph: —

5 The registrar may also furnish a special parking identification
6 plate bearing the "International Symbol of Access" to public or
7 private agency which services handicapped persons to be used
8 when such agency is transporting such persons. Said parking
9 identification plate shall be of such size and design as the registrar
10 shall require and shall be numbered and contain the name of the
11 agency to which it is issued. When used by the agency, said plate
12 shall be displayed so as to be visible through the left portion of
13 the windshield of a private passenger motor vehicle or a pick-up
14 truck used exclusively for noncommercial purposes.
