AN ACT ESTABLISHING A REVOLVING FUND FOR BOARDS OF HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 53F the following section: —

3 Section 53G. Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-
4 three a city or town may establish in the town treasury a revolving
5 fund which shall be kept separate and apart from all other monies
6 by the treasurer and in which shall be deposited all fees charged
7 by the board of health for the purpose of offsetting costs incurred
8 by said board for services rendered to said town by engineers,
9 attorneys and other persons who give professional and technical
10 advice to evaluate and provide information on proposals being
11 considered by said board.

12 The revolving fund shall be expended at the direction of the
13 board of health without further appropriation provided that such
14 funds are to be expended only for expenses incurred by said board
15 in connection with carrying out its responsibilities under the law.

16 Any excess not expended by the board of health in evaluating
17 a proposal shall be returned to the applicant.
