AN ACT TO PROMOTE HOMEOWNERSHIP IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary, any
- 2 employee with more than one year of service to the Common-
- 3 wealth who is a first time home buyer may withdraw with no
- 4 penalty his or her accumulated state retirement funds for the pur-
- 5 pose of applying said funds to a down payment.
