AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NOTIFICATION OF LEGISLATORS OF CERTAIN ACTIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting at the end of paragraph four the following:
- 3 Said secretary-treasurer shall cause to be sent, written
- 4 notification to the elected state senator and state representative
- 5 whose district may be impacted or affected by any action taken
- 6 by said authority. Written notice shall be sent 30 days prior to
- 7 the commencement of any action taken by the authority. Actions
- 8 taken by the authority include but are not limited to the following:
- 9 zoning changes, land use changes, leases, development plans,
- 0 community relations projects, environmental impact studies,
- 1 executory and non-executory contracts, and any existing
- 2 agreements entered into by the authority.
