AN ACT REQUIRING AUTOMOBILE TOW OPERATORS TO ACCEPT MAJOR CREDIT CARDS IN PAYMENT OF OBLIGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22D of Chapter 40 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "period" in line 30
3 the following sentence: — Such liability may be paid by a credit
4 card, as defined by section 1 of chapter 140C, issued by a bank,
5 as defined in section 1 of chapter 167, upon presentation of
6 suitable identification.

1 SECTION 2. Sections 6B and 6C of chapter 159B of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by adding after the first
3 paragraph the following new paragraph: —
4 Such charges may be paid by a credit card, as defined by section
5 1 of chapter 140C, issued by a bank, as defined in section 1 of
6 chapter 167, upon presentation of suitable identification.
