

By Mr. Mann of Hanson, petition of Charles W. Mann relative to the issuance of licenses to operate certain private business schools in the Commonwealth. Education, Arts and Humanities.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO OPERATE CERTAIN PRIVATE BUSINESS SCHOOLS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 75D of the General Laws  
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition is hereby amended by  
3 striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following sentence: — The provisions of this chapter shall not  
5 apply to any private business school which charges tuitions not  
6 exceeding three hundred dollars provided however that such  
7 private business schools shall be subject to the bonding provisions  
8 of section fourteen and, the provisions relating to personal service  
9 contracts contained in section thirteen K of chapter two hundred  
10 and fifty-five.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 75D is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following sentence: — The provisions of this chapter shall not  
4 apply to any private business school which charges tuitions not  
5 exceeding an amount to be determined by the commissioner of  
6 education in excess of three hundred dollars plus the percentage  
7 increase of tuitions of private business schools over three hundred  
8 dollars since 1988, provided however that such private business  
9 schools shall be subject to the bonding provisions of section  
10 fourteen and, the provisions relating to personal service contracts  
11 contained in section thirteen K of chapter two hundred and fifty-  
12 five.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of SECTION 1 of this act shall  
2 expire on January 1, 1992.

1 SECTION 4. The provisions of SECTION 2 of this act shall  
2 take effect as of January 1, 1992.
