AN ACT RELATIVE TO LIMITING CONTRIBUTIONS OF POLITICAL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 7 of Chapter 55 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 766 of the Acts of 1987 is hereby further
- 3 amended by inserting after the fourth sentence, the following: —
- 4 No candidate or a committee organized on his or her behalf
- 5 shall knowingly accept contributions from such political
- 6 committees or from a person acting under the authority of or on
- 7 behalf of such committee, which, in the aggregate of all such
- 8 contributions from all such political committees exceed in any
- 9 calendar year a sum of \$10,000.
