

SECTION 2. The balance of one hundred and forty-nine thousand, nine hundred and forty-eight dollars and sixty cents and any balance not appropriated as authorized by section one, may be invested in government bonds or other bonds or notes which are legal for the investment of funds by savings banks under the laws of the commonwealth. Such sums may thereafter be appropriated and expended for any purpose for which money may be borrowed under the provisions of sections seven and eight of chapter forty-four of the General Laws for a period of ten years or more.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 688* AN ACT DESIGNATING THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE LOCATED AT THE JUNCTION OF CONCORD AVENUE AND THE ALEWIFE BROOK PARKWAY IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, AS THE ALBERT S. TEEVEN, JR. MEMORIAL CIRCLE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The traffic circle located at the junction of Concord avenue and the Alewife Brook parkway in the city of Cambridge shall be known and designated as the Albert S. Teeven, Jr. Memorial Circle, and a suitable tablet or marker bearing said designation shall be erected at said traffic circle by the metropolitan district commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

*Chap. 689* AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CREDIT FOR PRIOR SERVICE TO BE GIVEN TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE UPON THEIR RETIREMENT.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the contrary, any person now employed as a meter reader in the water department of the city of Lawrence, for the purpose of determining his respective retirement allowance under the contributory retirement system of said city, shall have credited to him, as creditable service, the periods during which he was separated from the service of said city through no fault of his own; provided, that, any such person shall pay into the annuity savings fund of said system in one sum or by instalments, an amount equal to that which would have been withheld from his regular compensation for services had he been in the employ of said city during said period.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
