AN ACT RELATIVE TO PREMIUM CREDITS ON MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE POLICIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 2 of chapter 703 of the acts of 1983,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 The commissioner shall not make any rule or regulation which
6 denies a premium credit to a policyholder, who is the principal
7 operator of the insured vehicle, on the basis of a surchargeable
8 incident charged to another listed operator if such operator holds
9 a policy of their own, nor shall the commissioner make any rule
10 or regulation which denies a premium credit to a policyholder,
11 who is the principal operator of the insured vehicle, on the basis
12 that another listed operator has less than three years driving
13 experience if such operator holds a policy of their own.
