AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM THE SALES TAX FOR GOLD COINS OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 (11) Sales of coins minted by the United States and any use
- 4 of monies of the United States as defined in 31USC Section 5103
- 5 regardless of the valuation of said monies.
