By Mr. Jakubowicz of Pittsfield, petition of Robert F. Jakubowicz relative to the appointment of a joint special committee to make an investigation and study of the feasibility of providing independent counsels to prosecute certain state agencies, employees or officers. The Judiciary.

## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

1 *Ordered*, That a joint special committee, to consist of four  
2 members of the House of Representatives to be designated by the  
3 Speaker who shall also designate one such member as co-  
4 chairperson and four members of the Senate to be designated by  
5 the President who shall also designate one such member as co-  
6 chairperson, be established for the purpose of making an  
7 investigation and study of whether a procedure should be  
8 established to provide for an independent counsel to investigate  
9 and/or prosecute certain state agencies, employees or officers  
10 when such a need arises.

11 Such committee should report its findings and any recommen-  
12 dations for legislative action based on its study with the clerks  
13 of the House and Senate on or before September 1, 1989.
