AN ACT CHANGING THE DEFINITION OF DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection 24 of chapter 90 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" in lines 351 and
4 352 and substituting in its place the word "eight."

1 SECTION 2. Section 24N of Chapter 90 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the word "ten" in lines 8, 49, and 50 and substituting
4 in its place the word "eight."
