AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GREATER LAWRENCE SANITARY DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH A DRUG ANALYSIS LABORATORY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Greater Lawrence Sanitary District is hereby authorized
2 to establish a drug analysis laboratory and testing center for the
3 purpose of performing analytical tests and other examinations of
4 samples of abused and controlled substances such as alcoholic
5 beverages and drugs which have been seized by law enforcement
6 officials and the results of such tests as are required as evidence
7 in court proceedings as necessary.

8 The district may expend such sums as may be appropriated for
9 the above purposes from the Drug Analysis Fund established by
10 section fifty-one of chapter ten of the General Laws.
