AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTRIBUTIONS TO AN ESTABLISHED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 17B of chapter 180 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
- 3 the word "chest", in lines 5 and 12, the words: — , an established
- 4 scholarship program.
