AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CLASSIFICATION OF THE POSITION OF EDGARTOWN HARBORMASTER AND SHELLFISH CONSTABLE IN THE DUKES COUNTY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section three
2 of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws or any other general
3 or special law or rule to the contrary, the position of harbormaster
4 and shellfish constable of the town of Edgartown shall be classified
5 in Group 2 for the purposes of said chapter thirty-two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the board of selectmen of the town of Edgartown.
