AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBOROUGH TO RENT, LEASE, OR CONVEY CERTAIN LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Middleborough is hereby autho-
2 rized to rent, lease or sell and convey under such terms and
3 conditions as it deems proper all or part of the land with the
4 building therein located in the towns of Middleborough and
5 Plympton bounded and described as follows:

6 Property described in a deed of Donald W. Guidoboni and
7 Mary L. Guidoboni to the Town of Middleborough dated May
8 4, 1988 and recorded in the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds
9 in Book 8431, Page 269.

1 SECTION 2. Use of the real property described in section one
2 may be for any purpose which the town of Middleborough
3 determines.
