AN ACT TO INSTALL A DERNE STREET PLAQUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The George B. Henderson Foundation shall be authorized to
2 prepare and install, at its own expense, a plaque commemorating
3 the origin of the name Derne Street. A member of the
4 Massachusetts Art Commission shall be appointed to the Derne
5 Street Plaque Committee. Said Massachusetts Art Commission
6 shall act in an advisory capacity relative to the design, installation,
7 and location of said plaque; which is to be inserted in the Derne
8 Street wall of the new garage constructed easterly of the State
9 House annex. Acceptance of said plaque by the Commonwealth,
10 and the Division of Capital Planning and Operations acting and
11 accepting on its behalf, implies a commitment by the General
12 Court to find the annual maintenance of said plaque by said
13 division under said art commission's guidance and guidelines; and
14 subject as well to the prior approval of the Massachusetts
15 Historical Commission.
