3 to make an investigation and study of House document numbered
4 171 relative to antipsychotic medication.

6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
