AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by the Honorable William
5 T. Hogan, Jr. as he is a justice of the district court department
6 of the trial court of the commonwealth in the city of Boston, on
7 June twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine between
8 Vicki Rachel Block of the city of Melrose and Michael V. Fair
9 of the city of Melrose and the state secretary shall issue to said
10 William T. Hogan, Jr. in his capacity as aforesaid a certificate
11 of such authorization.
