3 to make an investigation and study of House document 164,
4 relative to notices upon discharge of persons from the
5 Massachusetts Treatment Center.

7 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
9 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk
10 of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday
11 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
