The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT COMPANIES TO PURCHASE OIL AND OTHER FUEL SUPPLIES WITHOUT BIDS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize certain
3 purchases of oil and other fuel supplies without bids, therefore
4 it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 234 of the acts of 1985, as most recently amended by
2 chapter 137 of the acts of 1987, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 Section 3. This act shall be inoperative on July first, nineteen
6 hundred and ninety-one.
