3 investigation and study of House document numbered 5870
4 relative to the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority.
5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk
9 of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday
10 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
