AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 1 the following section: —

3 Section 1A. Whenever any person required to report under the
4 provisions of section fifty-one A of chapter one hundred and
5 nineteen is issued or reissued a license or certificate to engage in
6 a business or profession, the issuing agency shall send such person
7 a statement informing them of their obligations under said section
8 fifty-one A.

9 Said statement shall contain a statement that such person
10 understands their obligations under said section fifty-one A and
11 the punishment for failure to comply which shall be signed by such
12 person and returned to the issuing agency.

13 As an alternative, the issuing agency may include the required
14 statement on application forms for such licenses or certificates.
