AN ACT DIRECTING THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY RETIREMENT BOARD TO GRANT CREDITABLE SERVICE TO GEORGE T. NAWN, SR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and
2 in order to promote the public good, the Middlesex County
3 Retirement Board is hereby authorized and directed to credit
4 George T. Nawn, Sr., a building commissioner for the Town of
5 Tewksbury, who, as a result of wrongful termination of his
6 employment by the Town of Tewksbury lost certain retirement
7 benefits, for creditable service for the period May 1, 1973 through
8 November 26, 1986, in an amount he would have been entitled
9 to be credited had he continued in service for said period with
10 the Town of Tewksbury. No such creditable service shall take
11 effect until said George Nawn shall pay into the annuity savings
12 fund of the Middlesex County Retirement System such amount
13 with interest as said retirement board may determine as being
14 equal to that which he would have paid into said fund had he been
15 a member in service during said term in accordance with the
16 provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
