The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY OF SPECIAL EDUCATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts assume
- 3 and pay all of the mandated costs, including but not limited to
- 4 transportation and education, as outlined under Massachusetts
- 5 General Laws, Chapter 766 et seq.

It is hereby ordered that the bill be read a second time on the 15th day of March, 1908.
