

SENATE No. 1330

[SENATE, NO. 1326, REPRINTED AS AMENDED]

[Senate, February 5, 1991 — Rules of the Senate as most recently in effect adopted as permanent rules with the following changes:]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

1 By adding at the end of Rule 7 the following new paragraph: —

2 “When the printing of the calendar required under this rule is
3 suspended under the provisions of Rule 5A, a session shall be
4 considered informal and no matter shall be considered if a member
5 prior to said session requested that the matter be held for
6 consideration or if a member at said session objects thereto.”;

7 By striking out the second sentence of paragraph (b) of Rule
8 13 and inserting in place thereof the following:

9 “The President shall in making such appointments give
10 consideration to representation of both the majority and minority
11 parties relative to their respective representation in the Senate and
12 in any event shall reserve at least two positions on the Senate
13 Committee on Ways and Means and at least one position upon
14 each standing or special committee for a Senate member of the
15 minority party and appointments to such positions shall be made
16 by the Senate minority party leader.”;

17 By adding after Rule 44 the following:

18 “44A. A motion to amend may be made by up to three members
19 whenever it is clearly indicated thereon.”; and

20 By adding after Rule 64 the following:

21 “65. The Senate shall meet no later than the third Friday
22 following the convening of the first annual session of a General
23 Court for the purpose of adopting permanent rules of the Senate.”.
