

SENATE No. 1440

[Senate, March 14, 1991 — Offered by Senator David H. Locke.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

1 *Ordered*, That the joint special committee established by
2 Senate Order, No. 1825 of nineteen hundred and eighty-nine and
3 revived and continued by Senate Order, No. 1325 of nineteen
4 hundred and ninety-one, is hereby dissolved; and

5 That a joint special committee, to consist of six members of
6 the Senate, no fewer than two of whom shall, in accordance with
7 their proportional representation in the Senate, be members of
8 the minority party, to be designated by the President thereof and
9 eleven members of the House of Representatives, no fewer than
10 three of whom shall, in accordance with their proportional
11 representation in the House of Representatives, be members of
12 the minority party, to be appointed by the Speaker thereof, be
13 established for the purpose of recommending a new division of
14 the commonwealth into congressional districts in conformity with
15 the law. The Committee may expend for clerical and other
16 necessary expenses, including the procuring of maps or other data,
17 such sum as may be appropriated therefor; shall be provided with
18 quarters in the State House; and shall be entitled to receive from
19 the State Secretary a tabulated statement showing the 1990 Census
20 data arranged by census block and precinct. The committee may
21 make a report to the General Court by filing the same with the
22 Clerk of the House not later than the first Wednesday of
23 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-one, with drafts of
24 legislation as may be necessary to comply with the provisions of
25 the Constitution in relation to the aforesaid matters.
