By Mr. White, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1447) of W. Paul White for legislation to authorize the State Retirement Board to credit certain years of service of Stephen J. O'Brien for pension purposes in computing his retirement allowance. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RETIREMENT BOARD TO CREDIT CERTAIN YEARS OF SERVICE OF STEPHEN J. O'BRIEN FOR PENSION PURPOSES IN COMPUTING HIS RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 state retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to credit
3 the term of service of Stephen J. O'Brien as an operator in the
4 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority during the period
5 from May twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine to
6 September twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven for
7 pension purposes in computing his retirement allowance;
8 provided, however, that he pays into the fund of said system such
9 amount with interest as said retirement board may determine as
10 being equal to that which he would have paid into said fund had
11 he been a member in service during said term in accordance with
12 the provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
