AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF ATHOL TO ISSUE AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO DOROTHY WILLHITE, D/B/A ATHOL STEAK HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws, the licensing authority in the town of Athol is hereby
4 authorized to issue a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages
5 to be drunk on the premises under the provisions of section twelve
6 of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight to Dorothy Willhite,
7 d/b/a/ Athol Steak House. Said license shall be subject to all the
8 provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, except
9 said section seventeen; provided, however, that the licensing
10 authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other
11 persons, organization, corporation or location for not less than
12 one year; and provided further, that the issuance of this license
13 shall reduce by one any increase in licenses issued due to census
14 reapportionment under the provisions of said section seventeen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
