AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chap-
2 ter two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by James W. Cashman of
5 Newton, in the town of Amesbury, on October fifth, nineteen
6 hundred and ninety-one, between Julie B. Hume and Marc M.
7 Deschenes, both of the town of Amesbury, and the state secretary
8 shall issue to said James Cashman in his capacity as aforesaid a
9 certificate of such authorization.
