Accompanying the fifth recommendation of the State Lottery Commission (House, No. 152). Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE OPERATION OF THE STATE LOTTERY.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which in part is to provide at once additional
3 revenue for the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to
4 be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as inserted by
2 Chapter 813 of the Acts of 1971 and amended by Chapter 156
3 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by inserting the
4 following paragraph at the end of said Section 24: The
5 Commission is hereby authorized to sell such surplus equipment
6 and material as is no longer required in the conduct of such State
7 Lottery.

8 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary,
9 the proceeds of the sale of any equipment shall be credited in
10 accordance with the provisions of Section 35(c) of Chapter 10 of
11 the General Laws.
