AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE CONDUCT OF BEANO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 37 of Chapter 10 as inserted in the General Laws by
- 2 Section 1 of Chapter 729 of the Acts of 1973 and amended by
- 3 section 2 of Chapter 492 of the Acts of 1974, is hereby further
- 4 amended by striking out the first sentence of paragraph one and
- 5 inserting in its place the following: —
- 6 The director may license any organization licensed to conduct
- 7 the game of beano under the provision of section thirty-eight to
- 8 sell lottery tickets or shares; provided that such tickets are sold
- 9 only on the premises of said organization for which such license
- 10 has been issued; and provided further, that the funds derived
- 11 therefrom shall be used exclusively for educational, charitable and
- 12 religious purposes.
