

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 296

By Mr. Manning of Milton, petition of M. Joseph Manning for legislation to insure payment of prevailing wages of public construction projects. Commerce and Labor.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

### AN ACT TO INSURE PAYMENT OF PREVAILING WAGES OF PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 149, Section 27B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

3 On all construction sites within the Commonwealth of  
4 Massachusetts the awarding authority shall insure that the  
5 prevailing wage rate for each classification of worker to be  
6 employed at the construction site be posted at a location  
7 convenient for employee inspection. The posting shall further  
8 contain the following statement in bold print: —

9 “Failure of the employer to pay the posted hourly wage rate  
10 for the designated craft listed above is a violation of MGL C 149  
11 Section 26. Employees not receiving such rates of pay should  
12 report this violation to the Commission of Labor and Industries,  
13 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, MA.”
