

By Mr. Manning of Milton, petition of M. Joseph Manning for an investigation and study by the Commissioner of Insurance relative to certain premiums paid by employers to the Workers' Compensation Fund. Commerce and Labor.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE RELATIVE TO CERTAIN PREMIUMS PAID BY EMPLOYERS TO THE WORKERS COMPENSATION FUND.

1 *Resolved*, That the Commissioner of Insurance is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the discrepancy that exists between construction
4 industry employers who pay lower wages to their employees and
5 those construction employers who pay higher construction
6 industry employee wages and thereby generating higher premiums
7 for those employers.

8 Said commissioner shall report to the General Court the results
9 of such investigation and study and its recommendations to
10 balance such inequity through appropriate rate making structure
11 changes, shall review the provisions of section fifty-three A of
12 chapter one hundred fifty-two to determine the extent of any such
13 inequity, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
14 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of
15 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday
16 in December, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
