By Mr. Manning of Milton, petition of M. Joseph Manning relative to further regulating armored car services. Public Safety.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING ARMORED CAR SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 147 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of the definition of “watch,
3 guard or patrol agency”, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition,
4 the following: — provided, however, that nothing in this
5 paragraph shall be construed to exempt operators or guards of
6 armored vehicles so-called, or those similarly engaged to carry
7 money and other such valuable documents for hire or reward.

1 SECTION 2. Section 29 of said chapter, is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the second paragraph, as appearing in the 1988
3 Official Edition, the following sentence: — The commissioner
4 shall promulgate such rules and regulations as he deems necessary
5 to properly enforce the provisions of sections twenty-two through
6 thirty.
