By Mr. Antonioni of Leominster, petition of Robert A. Antonioni for legislation to provide a mandatory sentence for the carrying of certain dangerous weapons. Criminal Justice.

AN ACT PROVIDING A MANDATORY SENTENCE FOR THE CARRYING OF CERTAIN DANGEROUS WEAPONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (a) of section 10 of chapter 269 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out the words "or for not less than
3 one year nor more than two and one-half years in a jail or house
4 of correction" and inserting in place thereof the words "or for not
5 less than eighteen months nor more than two and one-half years
6 in a jail or house of correction"; by striking out the words "The
7 sentence imposed upon such person shall not be reduced to less
8 than one year" and inserting in place thereof the words "The
9 sentence imposed upon such person shall not be reduced to less
10 than eighteen months"; and by striking out the words "until he
11 shall have served one year of such sentence" and inserting in place
12 thereof the words "until he shall have served eighteen months of
13 such sentence".
