AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any legislation to the contrary it is hereby
- 2 required that judges reside within the jurisdiction of the court they
- 3 will serve.

## AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, that the Secretary of the Interior be and he is authorized to

1. Investigate and report upon the condition of the public lands in the Territory of Arizona, and to report thereon to the Senate and House of Representatives at the next session of Congress.
