AN ACT TO ALLOW TOWNS TO CONDUCT REQUIRED OUT OF OFFICE VOTER REGISTRATION SESSIONS AT LOCATIONS DEEMED MOST EFFECTIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
3 following: — In towns divided into voting precincts, the registrars
4 shall, within sixty (60) days before the biennial state election, on
5 or before the last day fixed for registration, hold one session for
6 eight thousand (8000) residents, or any part thereof, in any
7 location other than the principal office which the registrars
8 determine best serves the public.
