In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT REQUIRING RETIREMENT BOARDS TO INFORM RETIREES OF ALL RESTRICTIONS PLACED ON THEIR FUTURE ACTIVITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subdivision (5) of section 20 of chapter 32 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs: —
3 (1) Each board shall, at the time of the retirement of any state,
4 county, town or other municipality member, give to such member,
5 in writing, notice of all restrictions placed on his/her future
6 employment while a retiree.
7 (2) Each retirement board shall, annually give to each member,
8 in writing, notice of any/and all changes in the law(s) which
9 pertain to the retirees and/or his retirement status regardless of
10 whether said member is a disability retiree or non-disability
11 retiree.
