AN ACT PERMITTING THE BURNING OF LEAVES IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 142J the following section: —
- 3 Section 142K. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
- 4 hundred and forty-two A and section one hundred and forty-
- 5 two B, in any city or town which accepts the provisions of this
- 6 section any person during the period of November first to
- 7 November fifteenth, inclusive, in any year may conduct the open
- 8 burning of leaves and shrubs on his property with the prior
- 9 approval of the fire department of such city or town.
