AN ACT REQUIRING LICENSING OR CERTIFICATION OF PESTICIDE APPLICATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 132B of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end of the second paragraph, the following: — and, provided,
4 further that the Department shall require that all persons who are
5 applicators of pesticides in public and private places used for
6 human occupation and habitation, shall be so licensed or certified
7 with such special designation. Residential properties with three
8 or less apartments shall be exempt from this requirement.
