AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FILING OF ZONING ORDINANCES WITH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The seventh paragraph of section 5 of chap-
- 2 ter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official
- 3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: —
- 4 If, in a municipality which is not required to submit zoning
- 5 ordinances to the attorney general for approval pursuant to
- 6 section thirty-two of chapter forty, a copy of the latest effective
- 7 zoning ordinance and zoning map is sent by the city clerk to the
- 8 attorney general.
- 1 SECTION 2. The first sentence of the eighth paragraph of said
- 2 section 5 of said chapter 40A as so appearing, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the first sentence.
