### AN ACT FURTHER GOVERNING THE ISSUANCE OF FIREARM IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 129B of Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the following language in the first  
3 paragraph: — “which such person shall be entitled to” and  
4 replacing it with “which in the discretion of the licensing authority  
5 shall be entitled to.”
