AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISTRICT COURT HOURS OF OPERATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 220 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out section 6, as appearing in the 1988
- 3 Official Edition and inserting in place thereof the following
- 4 section: -
- 5 Section 6. The division of the departments of the trial court
- 6 shall always be open, including evenings, and the business thereof,
 - 7 or of a justice thereof, may be transacted at any time, except that
- 8 such business shall not be transacted on a Sunday or on a legal
- 9 holiday unless it relates to an application which, in the opinion
- 10 of the justice to whom it is made, is of pressing necessity, or for
- 11 the purpose of instructing or discharging a jury, receiving a verdict
- 12 or adjourning; provided that, if the convenience of the public so
- 13 requires, the divisions shall be open for the transaction of business
- 14 on such Sunday, not legal holidays and during such hours thereof
- 15 as the administrative justice of the department may determine.
- 16 This section shall not prevent the exercise of the jurisdiction of
- 17 any magistrate in criminal cases to preserve the peace or arrest
- 18 offenders.
 - 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
