AN ACT EXEMPTING HANDICAPPED PERSONS FROM CERTAIN FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 handicapped persons, as defined by Section 21A of Chapter 71B
- 3 of the General Laws, shall be exempt from fees imposed by the
- 4 Commonwealth or by any of its political subdivisions, for the
- 5 personal use of recreational facilities.
